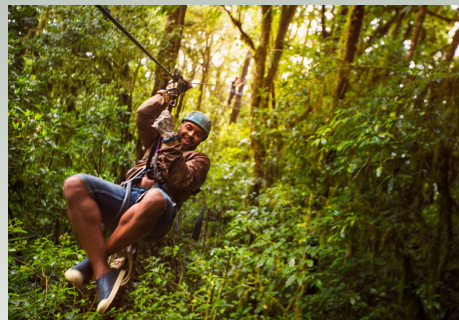

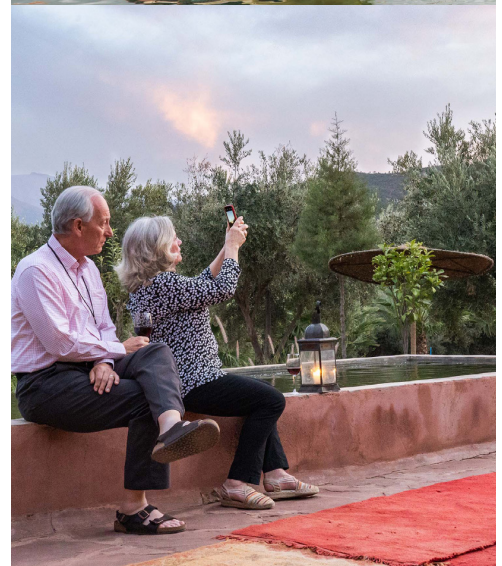
EXPEDITIONS — JOURNEYS AND FAMILY JOURNEYS

EXPEDITIONS — DAY TOURS

National Geographic Day Tours are one-day and half-day land tours and shore excursions for travelers short on time but big on exploring. Each of the 35-plus Day Tours in locations throughout the world is led by a National Geographic-trained guide, and most feature local specialists, such as archaeologists, marine biologists, chefs, farmers, photographers, historians, scholars and more. Operated by TUI, Day Tours launched in 2022 as shore excursions only, and in late 2023 introduced land tours with direct booking, adding convenience for travelers on the go or who have an extra day in their travel plans.
